

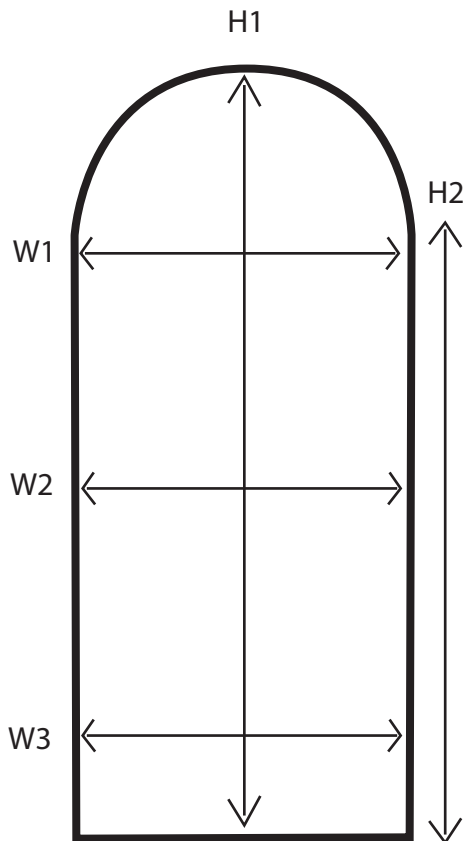

Arch / Round Top Measuring Instructions

When measuring for a wood screen door, be sure to measure the exact spot where the screen door will be attached to the door jamb. Typically, it is hung in front of the door stop. Measure the width at the top, middle, and bottom of the door jamb. Measure the center height of the door jamb at the tallest point of the arch. Then measure from the bottom of the door to where the arch starts. If the width measurements are different, we recommend going with the largest measurement. The door can always be trimmed where the door jamb is smaller. *For arch tops, it is very important to deduct 1/4" from the width for clearance. Please make this deduction before giving us the measurements, as the door is made to the measurements that are provide (we do not automatically make the deduction). Also measure the depth of the door jamb to determine what thickness (3/4" or 1-1/8") of door will fit. Make sure to check that the entry door handle does not stick out into the space of the screen door.
